

FLATHEAD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT 101
RESOLUTION NO. 3

WHEREAS, the Flathead County Water District 101 Board of Directors held a public hearing on the second day of August, 2016 at the Badrock Volunteer Fire Department to consider the adoption of a surcharge for service connections providing water to more than one structure; and

WHEREAS, the District's water system design and operation is intended to provide for the usage of one habitable structure per service connection; and

WHEREAS, there have been instances of residential customers of the water district connecting additional temporary living units such as occupied recreational vehicles for long periods of time; and

WHEREAS, public comment was taken during the hearing;

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing shall be posted in conformance with the M.C.A. 7-1-4127 in a local newspaper between 21 and 28 days prior to the hearing;


WHEREAS, notice of the hearing was mailed at least seven (7) days and not more than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing to the mailing addresses of all known service connection locations of the water system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Flathead County Water District 101 considers it both advisable and necessary to limit the use of each service connection to provide for a single habitable structure;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that temporary provision of water for recreational vehicles is allowed at any district service, but may not exceed a total of 21 days in any 12 month period;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that failure to comply with this resolution shall cause the surcharge of \$100 per month per connected additional living unit.
